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Café Yumm! to use locally grown beans

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Early next year, Café Yumm! will begin offering its rice and bean dishes made with Oregon-grown black beans, an atypical crop for the state.

[The Register-Guard reports](#) that the Eugene-based restaurant chain spent a year searching for a locally grown bean supply before connecting with Williams Hudson Bay Farm, an organic farm near Milton-Freewater, which signed a contract to grow 100,000 pounds of black turtle beans for Café Yumm!.
