## **Eugene-based Café Yumm!** opening first Idaho restaurant

The growing Eugene-based regional restaurant chain plans to open a location Jan. 29 in Eagle, Idaho, just west of Boise, according to a statement from the company.

The Idaho restaurant will be the 23rd Café Yumm! location, but the first outside Oregon or Washington state.
